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ARTIST BIOGRAPHY

David Triana, born in Bogotá, has spent over a decade shaping the dance music scene. Co-founding Downpitch Recordings with Tomas Station, he released and remixed works from artists like Alton Miller and Jordan Fields while curating events that introduced fresh electronic sounds to South America, featuring names like Jeremy Underground, Anthony Naples, and Pearson Sound.

Now based in London, Triana is a producer, DJ, and co-founder of the acclaimed Soursopp party, a staple in the city's music scene, regularly hosted at venues like Fabric and Lion & The Lamb. He has performed extensively across South America, North America, and Europe, holding residencies in Madrid, Istanbul, London, and New York.

As the founder of Triana y Hermana Juana, he merges Colombian and Caribbean rhythms with jazz and funk, creating a hypnotic fusion of acoustic and electronic sounds. His music has been featured on NTS, Red Light Radio, and WWFM, with releases on labels like Descendant of The Deep.

With a genre-spanning career and a passion for pushing sonic boundaries, David Triana continues to leave his mark on global dance music.
